



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS 2000 - APPROVED BODIES

Introduction

Under the Personal Protective Equipment Regulations 2000, Approved Bodies may be appointed to carry out various testing and certification functions. These procedures are necessary to demonstrate conformity with the basic health and safety requirements of the Personal Protective Equipment Directive (89/686/EEC) and to ensure that the quality of production PPE remains constant and in accordance with those requirements.

This document contains:

- a list of the Approved Bodies appointed by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry, under Regulation 14 and notified to the European Commission.
- details of the identification number issued by the European Commission to each Approved Body,
- the function that each body has been appointed to undertake are referred to by the appropriate Article within the Directive. These are:

Article 10: EC type-examination;

Article 11.A: 'EC' quality control system for the final product; and

Article 11.B: System for ensuring EC quality of production by means of monitoring.

Article 10, 11.A and 11.B

Respiratory protective equipment;
Eye protection;

Article 10 and 11.A

Protective clothing (including gloves, hoods & balaclavas) against flame, intense heat, molten metal, welding etc, industrial use and firefighting.

Article 10 and 11.A

Protective clothing including gloves, hoods, balaclavas, aprons, vests and related protectors for use in situations where one or more of the following applies:

- chemical and biological hazards;
- mechanical hazards;
- explosive hazards
- electrical hazards
- radiation hazards (ionising, non-ionising);
- sport and leisure hazards;
- foul weather, wind and cold hazards
- high visibility requirements

Protective clothing intended to protect against fire and microbiological hazards;
Lifejackets and buoyancy aids.

Safety, protective and occupational footwear;
Protective clothing & gloves against chemical, mechanical, heat & flame risks.

Article 11.B

Protective gloves (leather and synthetic coated);
Protective clothing (disposable suits made from paper and plastic materials);
Masks and respirators.
